What is UASMT

With the 4th Industrial Revolution in our midst, this is one of the careers of the future. Drones are everywhere, and Remote Pilots in demand, but with that comes the need to have services and repairs on drones. Hence the UAS Maintenance Technician career is born. If your passion is aviation and the technical side of this industry, then this course is for you.

Learn how to service, fault finding and repair a Drone. Whether it be Multi-Rotor or Fixed Wing, the requirement is needed.

UASMT Course

Upon successful completion of your course, you will be required to do a certain amount of hours at a Authorised Repair Centre and log your hours. Once this is completed, you can complete your application with the SACAA and will need to pay the SACAA Fee of R890.00 for the issuing of UAS Maintenance Technician Letter of Authorization (UASMT).

HOW LONG IS THE COURSE

This is a 2 (Two) week course, consisting of 10 days with a 2-Day weekend in-between. Theory is instructed in the morning, with the Practical followed in the afternoon.

All training is conducted at our premises in Honeydew, Johannesburg.
